3. Purpose & Audience:

The purpose of the organization is to gather people in a local community and build a membership style pub with lower cost food with accessible creature comforts. This style of pub would be aimed at younger adults; however, it would be accessible to all liquor consuming ages. The concept is to provide an area for people to gather and feel a sense of belonging in an area that is cared for by all individuals. The pub would not serve high percentage beverages, rather focusing on enjoying low percentage beverages with plenty of snacks. The common room would have sofas, large smoking chairs, and plenty of space for relaxation. There would be access to a variety of literature, board games, and outlets to allow for interaction between patrons but also alone time in public. To encourage buy in from patrons, the membership would include no tipping allowed, other than to upkeep the furniture and available content. All staff would have a livable wage.

4. Site Description:

The content pages of the website would have:

- the daily menu available at each location, with the limited options that are available
- a portal to sign up for membership, offering different options based on the needs of the individual
- a reservation system per location to ensure non-specific seating for a set period. This feature is to ensure that patrons would have a spot to eat, but would limit time in a dining specific area, and allow for continued patronage in a longer-term common room.

The photo gallery would have images of:

- clean dining and lounge areas
- friendly staff available behind the bar and kitchen counter
- warm gestures from the host and a security guard in front of the establishment
- the pub during peak service hours
- different entertainment options available
- individuals working alone and in groups on assignments or work
- staple meals that would rotate every week, paired with beer, water, and wine

The website would retain two forms:

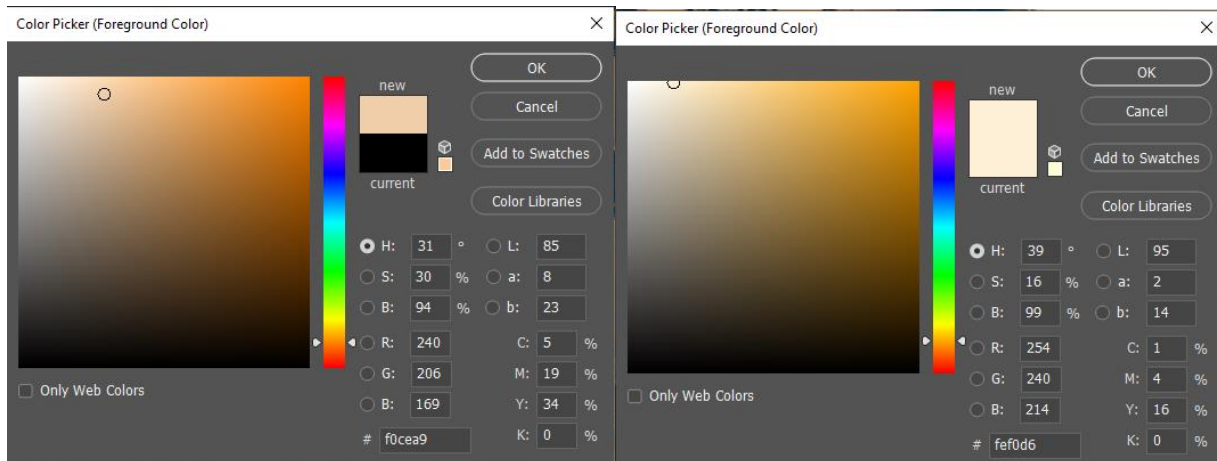
- a form for membership sign-up, requiring credit card information and government identification
- a form for reservations, to select and reserve daily time slots for main course consumption, with no more than 5 reservations allowed at a time per customer. If reserving as a group, all group members must be members (Non-members may not reserve, however, they are still permitted entry if seating is available, once a door fee is paid)

5. Site Colour Scheme

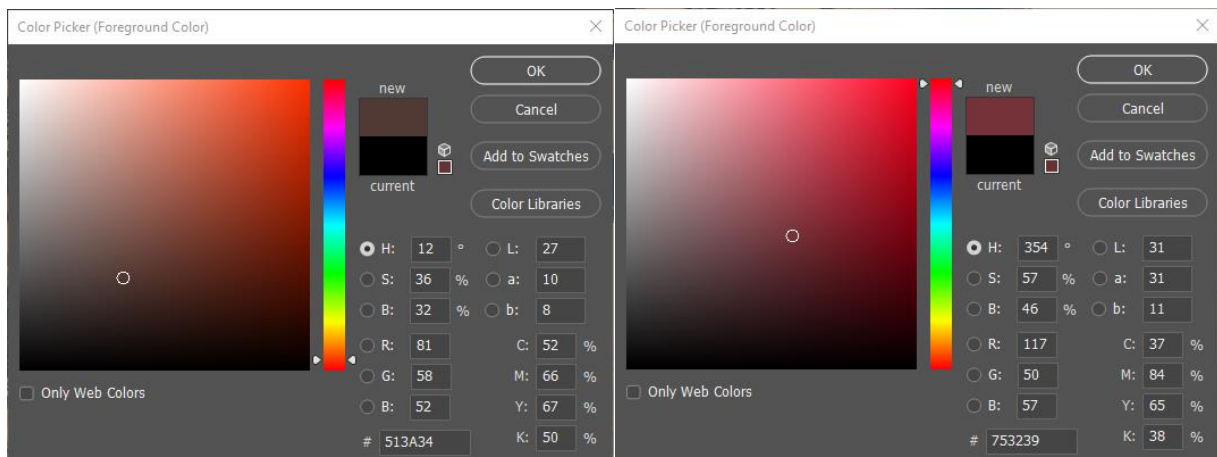
The site colours would be the colours found in this document's theme. But I also found this Photo by [Nikola Jovanovic](#) on [Unsplash](#) (2017):
