Use **Window > Workspace > Essentials (Default)**

Edit > Preferences > File Handling > Automatically Save Recovery Information **every 5 Minutes**

Name	Icon	Selects tool	Function
History Tool			Draws standard shapes that can be filled (Shift+F5) or stroked (border)

The tools in the table above are on the main right toolbar.

Name	Icon	Selects tool	Function
Move Tool		v	Allows you to move objects or layers
Marquee Tool		m	Draws standard shape <i>selections</i> that can be filled (Shift+F5) or stroked (border)
Quick Select Tool		w	Draws a selection area (paired with Magic Wand Tool)
Magic Wand Tool		w	Selects areas based on colour or tone (paired with Quick Select Tool)
Crop Tool		c	Removes portions of an image to create focus
Eyedropper Tool		I (capital i)	Selects colour from the active layer
Spot Healing Tool		J (capital j)	Clones selected areas and blends the pixels seamlessly with the target area
Clone Stamp Tool		S (capital s)	Covers an area with an identical copy of another area in the image
Paint Bucket		G (capital g)	Fills an area of the active layer in a particular colour
Horizontal Text Tool		T (capital t)	Allows you to add text in a new layer to your image
Set Foreground and Background Colours			Allows you to set two colours in the palette for use on your image. Default is black (foreground) and white (background).

Adjustments			Window > Adjustments The Adjustment palette contains all colour, tone and lighting correction tools
Layers		F7	Window > Layers Opens the layers palette to view, modify, duplicate and move layers.
Character			Window > Character Used with text, provides all specific text options.
